Advanced Dimensions of Learning Workshops:

The 3 day hub program is designed to empower educators to make meaningful and sustainable changes to their own pedagogical practice; as well as to provide a leadership model for designing and implementing DoL as a curriculum, assessment and pedagogy framework in any educational setting.

Professional Learning Journey:

Days 1 & 2:

Exploring effective strategies for integrating or refocusing on DoL:

These two days take an in-depth and hands on approach to introducing the key concepts of planning through the DoL framework. Participants will reflect on their current practice through a series of interactive strategies and protocols.

Planning and implementation goals will be set and a showcase program for Day 3 will be developed that highlights each participant/school's intended focus work as a result of this deeper reflection and sharing through the DoL learning design framework.

Day 3:

Sharing our learning through reflection:

Participants will showcase their work, this could be in the form of a unit of work; a series of lessons or a school wide curriculum strategy as designed during days 1 & 2 of this hub. This showcase of learning will include a discussion of design intentions, reflections of the use of DoL strategies and will incorporate structured self and peer feedback.
