## A 2-day workshop

### Background

For the past 10 years the ANSN has been exploring the relationship between teacher work and student work. This has been done with groups of teachers from every phase of schooling and every state and territory. It is based on the premise that if teachers and students produce learning together, the evidence of that learning can be found in the students work. It can be challenging to work with colleagues to give and get feedback on each others work. Protocols help us structure our conversations. They can be used to help us *learn from each other* by having productive conversations and they can help us *learn from the students* by providing us with structured ways to look at student work.

### In this workshop you will...

- Explore a number of protocols and their uses.
- Identify and practice ways to engage in conversations about teachers' work.
- Identify and practice ways to have structured conversations about students' work.
- Think about, and plan for using protocols in your school.
